Steve, 64, a former resident of Santa Clara, died Friday, Sep 10, of a massive heart attack. A graduate of Cupertino High School, and San Jose State University, where he played soccer for the Spartans, Steve was a founding member of the California band, "Papa Doo Run Run", in 1965, and performed with the band from '65 to '75, and again from '81 to '91. In addition to performing up to 200 dates a year around the world, Steve performed with PDRR at Disneyland throughout the '80s. For his work with PDRR, Steve earned a gold record, and a Grammy nomination, and was inducted into both his high school Hall of Fame, and the N. Cal Rock & Roll Hall of Fame.

After leaving PDRR in '91, Steve formed a duo, "The Soundbytes", which continued to perform throughout California until his death. Steve's winning personality, stage antics, musicianship, vocal ability, and perpetual smile were his trademark.

Steve also had a talent for construction, and for the past 20 years, owned a contracting business that specialized in high-end remodeling around the Bay Area.

Steve is survived by his wife, Denyse, daughters, Alex, and Geneve, and sisters, Sharon, Denise, Margaret, and Deborah. Steve's parents, Harold, and Ruth, and brother, Roger, have previously passed. Services will be held at 3 PM on Thursday, September 16, at the Green Valley Mortuary, 3004 Alexandrite Road, Rescue, CA 95672.
